



# Parent Testimonial

My son has struggled with depression and anxiety for quite some time. We have tried other types of therapy without much success. This past summer, he participated in a volunteer opportunity at the Cheff Center. At that time, he had never been around horses, and was actually afraid of them. After his first day, he came home and told me that when he was in the barn with the horses, his anxiety was completely gone.

He began the therapeutic riding program a few months ago. Within this time, his self confidence has grown, he looks forward to trying new things, and has learned how to be more aware of when his body is tense, and can now relax himself before the anxiety increases. He looks forward to seeing "his" horse, Ryan every week. He now carries a picture of Ryan with him to school and uses it as a focus point when he becomes anxious to help calm himself.

I can't begin to thank the staff, volunteers, donors, and of course Ryan, for everything they have done for my son. You all have given him his "spark" back that has been missing for a long time.



I started riding at Cheff this past summer. I have struggled with depression and anxiety for the past little while. I've tried many other strategies, none of them working. During my sessions, all my stress, anxiety, and depression go away.

I love "my" horse, Ryan, so much. He has helped me with my... well... everything.



When our daughter Olivia was diagnosed with autism, we suddenly felt very alone. We knew no other families with a child who had autism and had no idea where to start unraveling our lives. Things for months were chaotic as we buzzed from one appointment to the next. How were we going to parent a child who could not quiet her thoughts or lift her voice? Then we found the Cheff Therapeutic Riding Center and it felt like all at once things came together. It is not just a building with horses in it. It is so much more. In the Cheff Center we found stability, understanding and acceptance.... and Olivia found her voice. She was finally able to articulate all that swirled in her head. Through the Girls In The Barn program, Olivia was able to speak of worries, work on building friendships with other girls and learn ways to advocate for herself. We found our calm. Olivia is so much more confident, full of stories after each session about the horses, the staff and the volunteers. It is what she looks forward to most all week.
